

THE GRACE OF GOD

The word “grace” has a variety of uses and meanings in Scripture.

In the Old Testament, grace or chen (khane) generally means favor or good will.

Genesis 6:8

Genesis 39:4

In the New Testament, grace (charis/khar'-ece) also means favor or good will.

II Corinthians 9:6-8

Generally, however, the New Testament uses the word grace to denote the unmerited goodness or love of God to those who have forfeited it, and are by nature, under a sentence of condemnation.
